The scorekeeper should draw a single line at the end of first and third period and each overtime period, and a double line at the end of the second period and at the end of the game. In addition, he must inscribe the cumulative score in the appropriate box below.

Referee 1 should verify, at the end of each period, that all information recorded during the game is correct.

Referee 1 will also give the scoresheet a final check at the end of the game and sign it, along with all other officials.
